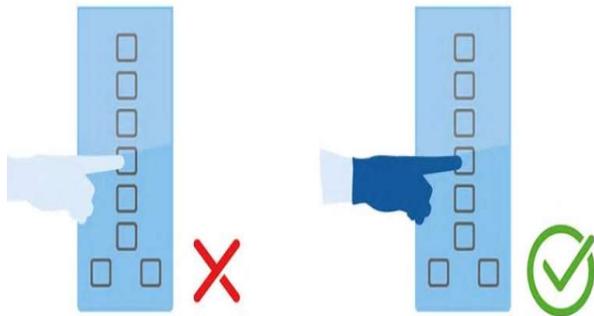


Passenger lifts – User safety during Coronavirus Pandemic

1 Avoid direct hand contact with buttons



To avoid the spread of coronavirus in lifts with push buttons, it's best not to touch the keys with your bare fingers. Opt instead for a gloved finger or use the end of a pencil or something similar to push the button.

If you need to use your bare hands, remember to wash them as soon as you can or use an alcohol-based hand-sanitiser.

2 Avoid crowds



If the lift is already full, be patient and wait for the next one. Or consider taking the stairs instead. It's best to travel in the lift on your own.

3 Practice social distancing



If you are in a lift with other people, ensure to stand at least 2 metre's away from your fellow passengers. If you have to cough or sneeze, turn away from others and use your sleeve or a handkerchief to prevent droplets from spreading and to limit the spread of coronavirus
